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Summary/Objective - To provide all functions of Service Coordination to include case management services and conduct developmental evaluations as part of an interdisciplinary team.

General Duties

- Provide all aspects of case management for assigned families
- Conduct initial and annual evaluations as second or third professional
- Assist families with transition process
- Staff assigned cases with interdisciplinary team
- Complete pre-enrollment process, as needed, to include coordinating initial evaluations and IFSPs
- Close cases as needed and approved by supervisor
- Make sure all paperwork/packets are completely filled and are accurate
- Meet all timelines (transition, six month periodic reviews, annual evaluations, etc.)
