**Summary/Objective** - Our ECI department is in immediate need of a full-time, organized and dedicated Intake/Referral Specialist to join our team. Our clients are children between the ages of birth to three years of age, who require flexible scheduling and exceptional follow-through. If you take a meticulous approach to your tasks, we're interested in hearing from you. This position involves constant communication with parents, physician offices and sometimes CPS and other agencies over the phone and sometimes in person.

## **General Duties:**

- Makes initial contact with referred families and provides information regarding services provided by ECI and explains the process prior to the initial evaluation
- Enters new referrals in EMR and assigns initial Service Coordinator/Intake Staff
- Schedules initial appointments for SC/intake staff
- Documents in EMR all attempts made to contact clients
- Closes new referrals as needed in EMR and state tracking system (T-Kids)
- Sends letter to referral sources for children not enrolled or loss to follow up
- Other project related duties as assigned
