The candidate should be familiar with billing insurance companies and Medicaid. This person will be a full-time, goal-oriented, revenue driven, highly accurate and motivated Biller.

Primary duties include, but are not limited to: consistent follow-up on unpaid claims utilizing monthly aging reports and filing appeals when appropriate to obtain maximum reimbursement. Secondary duties include but are not limited to: data entry of all patient demographics, guarantor and insurance information, posting procedures and insurance/patient payments, scheduling, and ensuring authorizations are current.

Responsibilities:

- Ensure all claims are submitted weekly
- Verifies completeness and accuracy of all claims prior to submission
- Accurately post all insurance and patient payments daily
- Timely follow-up on insurance claim denials
- Reading and interpreting insurance explanation of benefits
- Completion of monthly aging reports to follow-up on unpaid claims aged over 30 days
- Monthly patient statements
- Obtaining referrals/authorizations
- Scheduling of appointments
